


Saddleback Butte State Park ETI - Corral 138 Ride & Lunch Saturday, April 27th 2024

As of 2015, State Parks has enhanced the horse staging area at Saddleback Butte on the East of Lancaster. The installed fence identifies the horse staging area, plus, there are two step-over gates installed for easy access at the horse staging area, and, at the end of the horse trail. Please come and ride! Support your local California State Park! Increased attendance by campers, hikers and equestrians help to keep your local State Park stay open for all to enjoy.

The ride will be an out and back approximately 7 miles with a water stop. The trail is ideal for beginner riders/young horses and those who enjoy the beauty of our local desert. Sandy terrain! Beautiful views of the Antelope Valley and the San Gabriel Mountains. There may be many of our colorful Eastside wildflowers. The cost for the fundraising event is \$25 which includes; BBQ burgers, chips, soda and dessert, plus parking. Bring a folding chair. Lunch only \$10 RSVP by April 20!

Directions from Lancaster

Going north on the 14 Freeway, exit on 20th St. West. Make a right turn or go north on 20th Street West and make a right on Avenue J. Go East on Avenue J for 22 miles. (Pass the main entrance to Saddleback Butte State Park located at 170th St. East.) Turn right on 200th Street East (a small dirt road-look for sign). Go about ½ mile to the staging area. The staging area is located at 200th Street East and Avenue J-8. There is easy access pull-through and turn around. Coordinates 34.68319-117.77406
